If you remove or put on anything on stage, please note use of screen unless yours is a demonstration of clothes you have made. The Contestant will be placed in her starting position during the introduction so that she is ready to go directly into her act as the final words of her introduction (Contestant Name and Title) are completed.

Exact Time:

After accurately timing your talent presentation with a stop watch give exact time:

NOT TO EXCEED 90 SECONDS - NO EXCEPTIONS! Overtime CDs WILL BE Disqualified!

JUDGES WILL BE NOTIFIED IF YOU EXCEED THIS TIME PERIOD DURING YOUR PERFORMANCE.

You **MUST BRING WITH YOU** the **CD Master**, PLUS one (1) excellent CD **Copy** of the **Master** - of your accompaniment music. DEADLINE **March 26-27, 2010**. **CDs will not be returned.**
